Time Capsule Tasting: 2014 / Pinot Noir

Varying weather conditions year by year have an important impact on a finished wine. It's this vintage variation that excites us to follow a wine throughout its evolution and even reflect on where we were at the time that the grapes were coming of age on the vine.

About the grape....

Pinot Noir is, without a doubt, the most romanticized red wine in the world. No other grape brings out such emotion and devout worship among its enthusiasts. One of the reasons the Pinot Noir grape elicits such devotion is because it's really hard to grow. This finicky, thin-skinned grape buds early in the growing season, making it susceptible to spring frosts but prefers cooler to temperate climates with just enough heat and sunshine. But there's no question that when this problem child is raised right, it's sublime.

About the year....

2014. A year when millions of people flocked to the internet dumping buckets of icy water on their heads. And a year when the most we had to be outraged about was that the band U2 was presumptuous enough to automatically upload their album into our iTunes without asking us?! The nerve.

2014 presented a long, very warm and steady vintage. And here in this unique area with its short, hot growing season and desert-like conditions, a little extra hang time for grapes makes all the difference. In comparison to other years 2014 rates as one of the warmest, but rather than extreme heat spikes, the temperatures were consistent and cool at just the right times. Slow, steady and perfectly predictable, like an episode of Downton Abbey – one of 2014's most watched TV shows.

About the wines....

Martin's Lane 'Simes Vineyard' Pinot Noir, East Kelowna 2014

Winemaker Shane Munn takes a micro view of the vineyard, working single blocks or rows of vines employing gravity to move his grapes and wine only five times through the six-level, pump-less winery. The 'Simes Vineyard' is a cooler, steep, north-facing vineyard in East Kelowna, with granite-based soils, and planted to pinot noir clones 943 and 667. The northern aspect is rare, giving this already cooler site some additional freshness. After a native ferment, the two clones (picked a couple of weeks apart) were aged in extra tight grain French oak for 17 months (18 percent new) before being bottled unfiltered.

Quails' Gate Stewart Family Reserve Pinot Noir, West Kelowna 2014

One of Canada's original family-estate wineries, The Stewart family holds a history of grape growing that dates back to 1961 when they planted their first vines. The "Stewart Family Reserve" is grown on the volcanic slopes at the base of Mount Boucherie (a 50 million year old extinct volcano). Only the very best blocks are chosen for this Reserve blend, made under the guise of renowned winemaker Nikki Callaway. The 2014 was hand-picked and cold soaked for several days before a spontaneous fermentation began. The wine is barrel aged 10 months in French oak, of which about 50% is new.

Howling Bluff 'Century Block', Pinot Noir, Naramata Bench 2014

Located along the dramatic landscape of the Naramata Bench, Howling Bluff winery began in 2003 when owner and winemaker Luke Smith made the long awaited leap from stockbroker to farmer – a dream he'd had since university. Luke's love of Pinot Noir and his close attention to the terroir around him has led to Howling Bluff producing some of the top single vineyard Pinot Noirs on the Naramata Bench. The Century Block Vineyard name is an homage to the site that was home to over 100 different apple varieties back in the 1980s. Today the vineyard is planted to clones 666 and 777. The fruit spends a year in new French oak has the richness to hold its own.

Blue Mountain 'Reserve' Pinot Noir, Okanagan Falls, 2014

Located in the rugged and scenic hills of Okanagan Falls, Blue Mountain Vineyard and Cellars can make the rare claim of more than 30 years of continuous grape production by one family. In 1971, the Mavity family acquired the land. They commit themselves to sustainable farming and craft wines that are reflective of their nearly 90 acres of wild Okanagan Falls terroir. The Reserve Pinot Noir comes from a blend of five French clones planted 10-30+ years ago. After a native ferment, this Pinot spent 10 months in new-to-four-year French oak barrels.
