#### Time Capsule Tasting: 2011 / Syrah

Varying weather conditions year by year have an important impact on a finished wine. It's this vintage variation that excites us to follow a wine throughout its evolution and even reflect on where we were at the time that the grapes were coming of age on the vine.

#### About the grape....

Syrah. Let's clear something up right away: Syrah and Shiraz are the exact same wine. When Syrah (Sih-Rah) arrived in Australia from its birthplace in France, Australian winemakers took to calling it Shiraz (Shi – RAZ), instead of the grape's original name, Syrah. No matter what you call it, Syrah is typically a full bodied wine with a healthy dose of mouth-drying tannins and features flavors like berries, pepper, tobacco, and even smoked meat. There are several myths associated with the emergence of Syrah — one involves a Roman Emperor planting the grape in France in 280 A.D. and another involves a winemaker from Iran, where legend says the grape was actually born, bringing the vines with him to France in 600 B.C. where he settled in Marseilles. No matter how the grape actually arrived in France, suffice it to say, it has been there for a long time, and France – most notably the Rhone Valley region - is the place that made it famous.

#### About the year....

2011. A year when an estimated two billion people tuned in to watch the televised wedding of Britain's Prince William to Kate Middleton. Adele's "Rolling in the Deep" ruled the airwaves and Charlie Sheen was "winning".

2011 goes into the history book as an atypical, yet very welcome vintage. It was a long and cool growing season without the extreme daytime heat the Okanagan is known for. This resulted in grapes that achieved full phenolic ripeness at record low sugar levels (and thus low alcohol levels). For those who were patient, the resulting wines were built to age with high acids and structured tannins with elegance and nuance in the glass.

#### About the wines....

#### Nichol 'Old Vines' Syrah, Naramata Bench 2011

Nichol Vineyard is among the first three pioneering wineries on the Naramata Bench. The planting of their home vineyard began in 1989 and they're credited with having planted the very first Syrah vines ever in Canada. Nichol operates on a small scale and grow all of their wines within 900 meters of the winery doing virtually everything by hand with a low intervention approach. Nichol's 'Old Vines' Syrah grows on sloping granite at the northern end of the Naramata Bench and is a stunning example of Naramata terroir, really showing Syrah's savoury side in a fresh and elegant style. After destemming, the grapes fermented on skins in large open top fermenters before being basket pressed to neutral French barrique. After aging time in neutral barrique and puncheons, the wine was bottled un-fined and unfiltered.

#### Le Vieux Pin 'Classique' Syrah, South Okanagan 2011

Named for the solitary majestic old growth pine of their Oliver estate, Le Vieux Pin sits perched amidst the vineyards of the Black Sage Bench. Since releasing their first vintage in 2005, Le Vieux Pin has captured the essence of traditional French winemaking, along with the bold New World character distinct to the region. Considered to be a leading Syrah producer in Canada. This is a wine that captures the unique characteristics of South Okanagan: Heat of the dessert days married with the cold of desert nights. The 2011 is a complex wine with an intensely aromatic nose that has spices, black and white pepper and floral notes all jump out of the glass. Grown on the Golden Mile and Black Sage Bench, the wine was raised in French oak barriques for 17 months, 20% new.

#### Orofino Syrah, Similkameen Valley 2011

No one knows the Similkameen Appellation like Orofino does. John and Virginia Weber have over 19 years of experience making wines in the Similkameen and have an intimate relationship with each of the valley's distinct subregions. Formerly a high-school teacher and a nurse respectively, John and Virginia were feeling pretty settled into their life in Saskatchewan until they met the Similkameen Valley in 2001. Over the years Orofino has earned a devout following and 'cult' status among both consumers and sommeliers. With a big focus on sustainability (a 100% solar powered, strawbale tasting room) and low intervention winemaking; fresh, honest and terroir-driven is the Orofino style. This Syrah is dense yet fresh showing pruny, earthy, smoky, black berry, tobacco and leather notes with a black pepper and herb aroma. The grapes in the 2011 'Scout Vineyard' Syrah were hand harvested, gently crushed into one ton open top fermenters and aged 6 months in new and one-year old French and American oak barrels. Bottled un-fined and unfiltered in 2013.
